S4 Section Seminars 2008 is fast approaching, and Aal-Pa-Tah is excited to be hosting your Lodges at our Camp Tanah Keeta. This letter is to update you on some of the activities we have planned for the weekend. First of all, the updated weekend schedule is attached to this letter. The schedule may be tweaked a little more as Seminars nears, but as of right now, what I have attached should be complete.

Second, please encourage your members to bring their own camp chairs. We are strategically placing all of our camp's picnic tables to maximize their utility, but it will ease seating issues for the seminars venues greatly if participants bring a camp chair. Along that line, we are also having a "Dive-in" movie Friday night. Please let your members know they are welcome to bring their own pool float/tube if they want to lounge during the "Dive-in."

Finally, we have been planning all along to perform a Brotherhood Ceremony to induct members of our Lodge and to showcase our ceremonies to the Brothers of the Section. After discussing the ceremony with the Section Advisor, we have decided to also open up the ceremony to Brotherhood candidates from your Lodges. The ground rule from the Section is that each Lodge must provide its own Brotherhood counseling. This can be done either prior to Seminars - with the Lodge Advisor vouching for the candidates at registration - or by an authorized advisor from your Lodge attending our counseling during the weekend along with your candidates. As far as sashes go, your Lodge can either bring sashes, or pay \$14 per candidate at the onsite registration.

The Brotherhood schedule during Seminars is as follows: Brotherhood candidate meeting at **9:30 p.m.** on Friday night; counseling will start at **4:15 p.m.** on Saturday; and the ceremony will begin at **10:30 p.m.** Saturday night.
